

Kings Station Agents

1865 – 1932

1865-c.1889 **Henry King**

1879-1881 listed as station agent

No information found of King as agent besides this. There are numerous Henry Kings in the area at this time and all are listed as farmers in the census.

1889-c.1930 **Clarence E. Latham** (1863-1941)

1884 at Troy Business College for business & telegraphy

1889 starts as agent & telegraph operator at Kings

1905 station agent at Kings since April, 1889; promoted to a higher office (not stated what) in February

1920 telegrapher & agent until April

1922 & 1923 station agent at Kings

1923 sells creamery at Kings (photo 5 from near station)

1924 station agent at Kings in November

1930 station agent at Kings

1905 **Leon Allen**

1905 former assistant at Kings now agent; probably starting when Latham leaves in February; Allen dies in September from a hunting accident.

1905-1924 **Valorus C. Winney** (1882-1951)

1905 telegraph operator

1906 station agent at Kings in June and probably started in September of 1905 after Allen died

1909-1910 listed as agent at Kings

1915 still in Greenfield but no occupation listed

1918 telegraph operator at Saratoga Springs D&H station

1923 & 1924 station agent at Kings

1930 ticket agent at Saratoga Springs

1940 freight agent at Saratoga

1920 **L. J. Love**

1920 probably filling in for Latham in April

1922 **Merton H. Bishop** (1890-1962)

1917 railroad telegrapher at Camden, NY

1920 working in Saratoga Springs for the D&H

1922 listed as agent at Kings

1930-1940 telegrapher at Saratoga

1932 **Leo E. Remillard** (1892-1959)

1932 listed as agent for Kings in January; may have been filling in as he was the agent in Corinth for many years

1933 station closed & moved away from tracks
