

# Riverside Station Agents

1872 - 1962

- 1872-1887 **Irving J. Dunn** (1847-?)  
1870 listed as "Depot Master" in census (The Glen)  
1871 station agent at The Glen  
1872 probably starts at new Riverside station  
1887 left in March
- 1887-1902 **Jeff W. Waldron** (1860-1919)  
1880 railroad clerk at North Creek  
1887 now station agent at Riverside  
1900 station agent at Riverside  
1902 transferred to freight office in Glens Falls
- 1902 **Orley Hazelton** (1862-1932)  
1898 station agent at The Glen  
1902 new agent at Riverside, April 3rd  
1903-1927 in pulpwood business and working as a clerk for various businesses in Warrensburg  
1928 collector for water bills in Warrensburg
- 1902-1906 **William M. Clear** (1868-1961)  
1886-1902 telegrapher & assistant agent at Hadley  
1902 starts as agent in Riverside in September  
1906 transfers to Hadley station after Griffing resigns  
1922 transferred to Salem, NY station  
1924 transferred to Westport, NY station  
1927-1941 station agent at Ausable Forks
- 1906-1910 unknown
- 1910-1953 **Charles A. Clingman, Sr.** (1876-1953)  
1893 telegrapher in Plattsburg & Elizabethtown  
1901 telegrapher at Rouses Point; gets transferred to Cooperville, NY as station agent  
1902 transferred to Saratoga in June  
1903 transferred to Whallonsburgh as station agent  
1910 transferred to Riverside as agent  
1953 ends career in Riverside after a stroke in February (Charles on far left in 5<sup>th</sup> photo)
- 1953-1962 **Joseph M. McDowell** (1906-1994)  
1940 manager at A&P in Lake Placid  
1953 appointed station agent of Riverside at the end of March  
1962 station closes
