

Stony Creek Station Agents

1870 – c.1960

1874-1875 **Philip A. Whitaker** (1851-c.1936)
1870 laborer, living near The Glen
1874 Station Agent at Stony Creek in November
1875 Philip resigns and is leaving by July 1
1879-1881 Station Agent at The Glen; paid \$45/month
1884 brakeman on Adirondack Railway
before 1895-after 1920 Conductor for D&H

1879- c.1912 **Clarence E. Crannell** (1852-1912)
1879 station agent, \$35/month
1900 station agent and telegraph operator
1910 station agent, \$50/month (top photo far left)

c.1915-1923 **Irving Phillip Goodman** (1879-1964)
1900 bartender in Thurman
1910 telegraph operator in Thurman
1910 Station Agent in South Corinth
c.1915-1923 Station Agent at Stony Creek
c.1924-1929 possible Agent at The Glen
1933 Station Agent in Willsboro, NY

1930 **John Aufiero**
1930 listed as station agent when building burned in December; no bio found

Unknown **Eldon N. Dingman** (1897-1980)
His obituary mentions that he was the station agent for many years then later (c.1950-1970) was a Town Justice. He is listed as a farmer so may have been the part-time summer agent in the 1930s & 1940s.

1930 the station burned and was replaced with a passenger car

1932-33 summer agent only

1934 and later, flag stop only, no agent

1956 the passenger car was replaced with a shelter

c.1960 the shelter was removed
